- **Invitation to life @ R25 printed in 1993**
Young person's guide to Eucharist The Eucharist has always been central to Anglican Worship. But where does it come from? What difference can it make to our daily lives? How can we best prepare for it and take part in it? In this

readable booklet, John Suggit takes us step by step through the eucharist service of An Anglican Prayer Book, 1989, explaining the history of its various parts and showing its importance for our life today. It is a valuable guide written with confirmation candidates in mind. But others, parents of children admitted to communion and any who simply want to appreciate the Eucharist more deeply, will also gain much from it.

➤ **The Bible Today @ R25 printed in 2000**

This book looks at the meaning and purpose of the Bible. by Prof Suggit is meant for all who would like to know more about the meaning of this central act of the church's worship. It is especially useful for lay-ministers and clergy.

➤ **Mysterious Reality @ R52 printed in 2007**

God, the world and ourselves in the light of Richard Dawkins 'The God Delusion'. in this book John Suggit tries to explain something (but not much) of the mystery of our human life, and believes not only that Richard Dawkins, the eminent geneticist and professed atheist, does not have all the answers, but also that a true understanding of the Christian gospel, "opens up the possibility of promoting scientific endeavor of every kind".

➤ **St Mark the Evangelist, the gospel for today @ R70 printed in 2000**
